



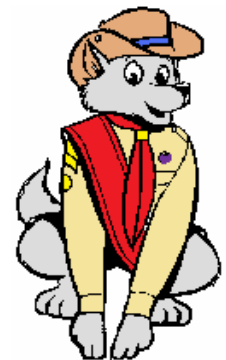
ODAWA AREA WHITETAIL CAMP 2010
